This gold highlights a beautifully aged, slightly antiqued finish that is warm, modern and sophisticated, works in a rusticinspired space, yet offers an old-world charm. When designing spaces for my clients, I find I'm drawn to unlacquered brass for bathroom fittings, lighting, cabinet hardware and accessories.

Create an upscaled yet comfortable décor for yourself by adding richly textured gold silk cushions to the room. Fabric is always a great way to punch up any space you're designing. With so

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many patterns and textures to select from, you're sure to find something to complement any décor style.
